

### **Options**

#### Option #1

Construction of the P & E Room and 1st floor improvements, plus the 2nd floor shell only. 2nd floor improvements - later date.

Phase I - 1st floor with improvements- 2nd floor shell \$5,807,470

Phase II - Construct 2nd floor improvements

\$1,167,343

Option 1 Total Cost =

\$6,974,813



### **Options**

• Option # 2

Construction of the complete building addition (1st and 2nd floor improvements) upfront.

Option 2 Total Cost =

\$6,767,533



### **Options**

#### Option #3

Construction of the P & E Room only. The 2nd floor addition would be constructed and improved at a later date.

Phase I - Construct 1st floor (improvements only) \$4,584,734

Phase II - Construct 2nd floor with improvements \$2,696,502

<u>Option 3 Total Cost = </u>

\$7,281,236

# Discussion and Next Step

Staff is recommending option #2

Construction of the complete building addition improvements (1st and 2nd floor improvements) upfront.

- Provides for Future Growth
- Centrally located for staff and citizens

<u>Option 2 Total Cost = \$6,767,533</u>
