## Statewide Mutual Aid System for Emergency's

- Potentially providing or receiving resources:
  - Public Works equipment
  - Police
  - Fire-EMS
  - public health expertise
  - environmental expertise
  - communications specialist
  - transportation resources



## AZMAC Resource Sharing

- Not obligatory, Avondale can refuse resource requests
- Can be reimbursed for any costs of providing resources to others
- Reimbursement agreement occurs prior to dispatching any resources
