Department Overview

- 4 Stations (4 engines, 1 ladder, 1 BC, 1 Utility, 1 TRT Support, 1 Brush)
- 75 personnel
 - 63 shift, 4 community risk reduction, 6 administration, 2 state fire training
- Nearly 11,000 calls for service



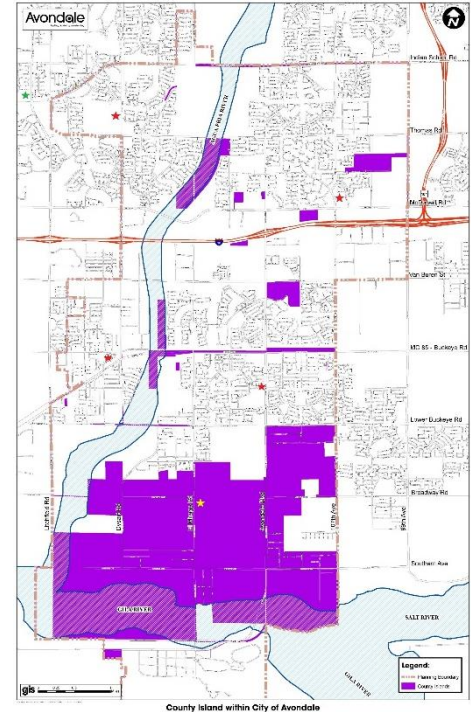
Project Update

- Insurance Services Office Evaluation
 - Project Manager: Assistant Chief Steve Ellsworth
 - Survey Documents Submitted
 - Site Visit Scheduled for June 28
 - Final report & rating expected by September 1
 - Current ISO rating: Class 4
 - Goal: ISO Class 1



Project Update

- County Island Fire District
 - Project Manager: Chief Adams
 - Informational brochure mailed June 8
 - Signature collection initiated June 19
 - 288 signatures required
 - Submission deadline August 18



Project Update

- Fire Code Update
 - Project Manager: Fire Marshal Jason Napier
 - Current code: 2003 International Fire Code
 - Update to 2015 IFC/Phoenix Fire Code with local amendments
 - Staff review complete – Attorney review underway
 - Scheduled for council discussion August 7
 - Scheduled for final adoption August 14



Project Update

- Community Medicine Pilot Project
 - Project Manager: Division Chief Troy Lutrick
 - Five city partnership (Goodyear, Avondale, Surprise, Peoria, Sun City)
 - Funding provided by Vitalyst Health Foundation
 - Focused on frequent 9-1-1 users (3/month or 12/year)
 - Pilot program initiated in late November 2016
 - Program concludes June 28
 - Seeking alternative funding sources



Project Update

- Ambulance Transport Agreement / CON
 - Project Manager: Assistant Chief Steve Ellsworth
 - Current agreement extension expires August 7
 - Parties working on an agreement revision
 - Scheduled for council action August 7
 - May go to RFP if agreement not reached
 - CON application process currently on hold



Project Update

- Apparatus Refurbishment
 - Project Manager: Division Chief Ben Avitia
 - First truck to the plant May 8
 - 160 day time period
 - Total of 3 trucks
 - Extend the vehicle life cycle by 10 years



Project Update

- EOC / TOC
 - Project Managers: Division Chief Troy Lutrick; Chris Hamilton (Engineering Project Manager)
 - Phase 1 completed (initial infrastructure)
 - PSA for design services – June 19
 - Expected completion June 2018
 - Operational for NASCAR November 2018



Project Update

- Assistant Fire Chief Recruitment
 - Project Manager: Chief Adams
 - Posting closes June 27
 - Assessment process scheduled for July 17-19
 - Target start date August 21
