Arizona State Legislature

- ❖ Over 1,200 bills introduced
- ❖ 7 bills passed
- ❖ 6 bills signed
 - ❖ SB1227: Colorado River Drought Contingency Amendments
- ❖ 1 bill vetoed
 - ❖ SB1143: conformity; internal revenue code; rates

Digital Goods

- ❖ SB1460: TPT; digital goods & services
 - ❖ Exempts Software as a Service
 - ❖ Fiscal impacts to State, Cities & Prop 301
 - ❖ Recommend Oppose

- ❖ SB1515: digital goods & services; taxation
 - ❖ Revenue neutral
 - ❖ Recommend Support

- ❖ HB2633: digital goods and services; TPT
 - ❖ Revenue neutral
 - ❖ Recommend Support

Texting/Distracted Driving

- ❖ 6 bills introduced
- ❖ SB1165: prohibition; texting while driving
 - ❖ Prohibits using mobile device except when in hands free operation
 - ❖ League Executive Committee voted to support
 - ❖ Recommend Support

General Government Legislation

- ❖ HB2201: partisan offices; cities; towns
 - ❖ Would require party designation on ballots
 - ❖ Recommend Oppose
- ❖ HB2158: food; municipal tax exemption
 - ❖ Prohibits taxation of food for home consumption
 - ❖ Recommend oppose
- ❖ HB2319: HURF; highway patrol; repeal
 - ❖ Removes DHS funding from HURF
 - ❖ Recommend Support
