Arizona State Legislature

- ❖ 1,318 bills introduced
- ❖ 331 passed the Legislature and were sent to the Governor
- ❖ 320 signed into law
- ❖ 11 vetoed
- ❖ Adjourned *sine die* 12:58am, May 28, 2019
- ❖ August 27, 2019, general effective date

State Budget

- ❖ \$11.8 billion signed June 6, 2019
- ❖ Provides \$18M divided equally among all cities/towns for infrastructure improvement (\$197,802 each)
- ❖ Highway Safety Fee Phase Out beginning FY2022
- ❖ \$15M to Water Quality Assurance Revolving Fund (WQARF)

Defeated Legislation

- ❖ HB2638: municipal tax; exemption; food
- ❖ HB2201: partisan offices; cities; towns
- ❖ SB1147: S/E tobacco products; vapor product

Vetoed Legislation

- ❖ SB1558: legislators; mileage rate; distance
- ❖ HB2473: state liquor board; membership

Signed Legislation

- ❖ HB2319: driving; wireless communication device; prohibition
- ❖ HB2027: online lodging marketplace; local taxation
- ❖ HB2672: vacation rentals; short-term rentals; regulation
- ❖ HB2757: tax provisions; omnibus

Signed Legislation

- ❖ SB1227: Colorado River drought contingency amendments
- ❖ SB 1154: primary date; first August Tuesday
- ❖ SB 1451: statewide ballot measures; circulators; procedures
