

A special meeting of the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Avondale, Maricopa County, Arizona, was held in the chambers of the Council in the Town Hall, in the Town of Avondale, Arizona, on Monday, the 29th day of April, 1957, at the hour of 7:30 O'clock P.M., pursuant to the foregoing notice of special meeting and consent thereto.

The Mayor called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following answered present:

The Mayor advised the Council that it was the first Monday following the twelfth day after the special bond election held in the Town of Avondale, Arizona, on the 15th day of April, 1957, and was the day and hour set for the canvass of the returns of election, which returns were delivered to and deposited with the Council by the election board that conducted the aforesaid election, within twelve days after the date of election, as prescribed by law.

The envelopes containing the official returns were, thereupon, opened by the Clerk, their contents exhibited to the Mayor and Common Council for examination and canvass, and upon careful examination the returns were proven and found to be correct, as determined by the election board.

Thereupon, Councilman Homer Tyler moved, seconded by Councilman Fred Campbell, Jr., put to vote and passed and adopted by the unanimous vote of the Mayor and Common Council, that the following certificates, embodying the findings of the Mayor and Council relative to the results of the election as to the question of the issuance and sale of \$26,000 principal amount of Town of Avondale Motor Vehicle Fuel Tax Anticipation Bonds, Series of 1957; Town of Avondale Sanitary Sewer Improvement Bonds, Series of 1957, in the principal amount of \$70,000; and Town of Avondale Sanitary Sewer Revenue Bonds, Series of 1957, in the principal amount of \$255,000, be adopted, and the Clerk was directed to file and record a copy of each of said certificates in the office of the County Recorder of Maricopa County, Arizona:

The Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Avondale, Maricopa County, Arizona, pursuant to the provisions of Title 9, Chapter 6, Article 5, Arizona Revised Statutes, do hereby certify as follows:

1. That pursuant to a resolution and order passed and adopted by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Avondale on the 7th day of March, 1957, an election of the real property taxpayers, who were in all respects qualified electors of the Town of Avondale, Maricopa County, Arizona, was duly and regularly held in the Town of Avondale, on the 15th day of April, 1957, for the purpose of submitting to the real property taxpayers, who were in all respects qualified electors of the Town, the question of whether the Town of Avondale should issue and sell "Town of Avondale Motor Vehicle Fuel Tax Anticipation Bonds, Series of 1957," as provided by the provisions of Title 9, Chapter 6, Article 5, Revised Statutes, the proceeds of which shall be used to acquire rights of way and to aid in the improvement, construction and reconstruction of portions of Central Avenue in the Town of Avondale, from U. S. Highway 80 north to the north city limits in said Town of Avondale, Arizona, and to pay administrative expenses in connection with such improvement, the bonds to be in the principal amount of \$26,000, to be in the denomination of \$1,000 each, to be numbered from 1 to 26, inclusive to be dated July 1, 1957, to bear interest at a rate not to exceed 5% per annum, payable semi-annually on the first day of January and the first day of July of each year from date of bonds until maturity, the bonds to mature on the first day of July in each of the years 1958 to 1967, inclusive, as follows: \$2,000 in each of the years 1958 to 1961, inclusive and \$3,000 in each of the years 1962 to 1967, inclusive.

2. That the total number of votes cast at the election in the Town of Avondale relative to the issuance of said bonds was as follows:

That the majority of the votes cast at the election relative to the issuance of the bonds, was in favor of the creation of the indebtedness described, by the issuance and sale of \$26,000 principal amount of "Town of Avondale Motor Vehicle Fuel Tax Anticipation Bonds, Series of 1957," and that by virtue of the premises, the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Avondale, Maricopa County, Arizona, do hereby order the issuance and sale of the bonds and the creation of the indebtedness to be evidenced thereby.

The Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Avondale, Maricopa County, Arizona, pursuant to the provisions of Title 35, Chapter 3, Article 3, Arizona Revised Statutes, do hereby certify as follows:

1. That pursuant to a resolution and order passed and adopted by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Avondale, on the 7th day of March, 1957, an election of the real property taxpayers, who were in all respects qualified electors of the Town of Avondale, Maricopa County, Arizona, was duly and regularly held in the Town of Avondale on the 15th day of April, 1957, for the purpose of submitting to the real property taxpayers, who were in all respects qualified electors of the Town, the question of whether the Town of Avondale should issue and sell "Town of Avondale Sanitary Sewer improvement Bonds, Series of 1957, " as provided by Title 35, Chapter 3, Article 3, Arizona Revised Statutes, the proceeds of which shall be used to aid in the construction of complete sanitary sewer facilities, including outfall line, collection system and sewage treatment plant, within and without the Town of Avondale, Arizona, the bonds to be in the principal amount of \$70,000, to be in the denomination of \$1,000 each, to be numbered from 1 to 70, inclusive, to be dated July 1, 1957, to bear interest at a rate not to exceed 5% per annum, payable semi-annually on the first day of January and the first day of July in each year from date of bonds until maturity, or until paid, said bonds to mature on the first day of July in each of the years 1959 to 1976, inclusive, as follows: \$3,000 in each of the years 1959 to 1965, inclusive; \$4,000 in each of the years 1966 to 1971, inclusive, and \$5,000 in each of the years 1972 to 1976, inclusive.

That pursuant to a resolution and order passed and adopted by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Avondale on the 7th day of March, 1957, an election of the real property taxpayers, who were in all respects qualified electors of the Town of Avondale, Maricopa County, Arizona, was duly and regularly held in the Town of Avondale, on the 15th day of April, 1957, for the purpose of submitting to the real property taxpayers, who were in all respects qualified electors of the Town, the question of whether the Town of Avondale should issue and sell "Town of Avondale Sanitary Sewer Revenue Bonds, Series of 1957," as provided by the provisions of Title 9, Chapter 5, Article 3, Arizona Revised Statutes, the proceeds of which shall be used to aid in the construction of complete sanitary sewer facilities, including outfall line, collection system and sewage treatment plant, within

and without the Town of Avondale, Arizona, and to pay all engineering, legal and financial advisory fees, together with all other contingent costs in connection with the sanitary sewer utility undertaking, the bonds to be in the principal amount of \$255,000, to be in the denomination of \$1,000 each, to be numbered from 1 to 255, inclusive, to be dated July 1, 1957, to bear interest at a rate not to exceed 5% per annum, payable semi-annually on the first day of January and the first day of July of each year from date of bonds until maturity, unless called for redemption prior thereto, the bonds to mature on the first day of July in each year during a period of years to be determined by the Mayor and Common Council, but not to exceed thirty years from the date of said bonds, in principal amounts to be provided hereafter by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Avondale, bonds to be subject to prior redemption as determined by the Mayor and Common Council, at the option of the Town of Avondale.

2. That the total number of votes cast at the election in the Town of Avondale, relative to the issuance of said bonds, was as follows:

That the majority of the votes cast at the election was in favor of the creation of the indebtedness described, by the issuance and sale of \$255,000 principal amount of "Town of Avondale Sanitary Sewer Revenue Bonds, Series of 1957," and that by virtue of the premises, the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Avondale, Maricopa County, Arizona, do hereby order the issuance and sale of the bonds and the creation of the indebtedness to be evidenced thereby.

The form of the bonds authorized to be issued shall be prepared by the mayor and Common Council by resolution and entered upon the minutes, as prescribed by law.



The total number of votes cast at the election for the nomination of seven (7) councilmen was as follows:


