

Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Council of the City of Avondale, Arizona, held at 7:30 P.M., December 20, 1971, in the Council Chambers of the Avondale City Hall

Minutes of the Previous Meeting:

Minutes of the regular meeting of December 6, 1971, were included as part of the Agenda for Council's review. Since there were no corrections or additions to the minutes, Mayor Allen moved, seconded by Councilwoman Lorenz, that the minutes be approved as reviewed by the Council. Unanimously carried.

Reports:

- (a) Included with the Agenda was the monthly Revenue and Expenditure Report for the month of November 1971, submitted by the City Manager.
- (b) Included with the Agenda was the Public Works Department Activity Report for the month of November submitted by Public Works Director Pipkin.
- (c) Included with the Agenda was the Police Department Activity Report for the month of November submitted by Police Chief Lopez.

Demand Claims:

The City Manager respectfully requested that an additional demand claim number 11965, \$416.50, payable to the Avondale School for the Christmas Dinner. Vice-Mayor Campbell moved that the demand claims including the additional claim submitted for payment be approved. Motion seconded by Councilman Crane. Unanimously carried.

Unfinished Business:

- (a) The matter of appointing a Board of Appeals as provided for in the Uniform Building Code. The following individuals were recommended to this Board: Ralph Moore, Ray Kloessen, Ronald Blair, Wayne Van Horn, Donald Godman and John W. Mabis, Building Inspector as Secretary. Vice-Mayor Campbell moved that the individuals recommended be appointed to the Board of Appeals. Motion seconded by Councilman Crane. Unanimously carried.
- (b) The execution of an agreement to lease a computer from Automated Business Systems was discussed by the City Attorney with the Mayor and Council. The City Attorney recommended inserted changes to the lease. Vice-Mayor Campbell moved that the lease be executed if the recommended changes were acceptable to Automated Business Systems as recommended by the City Attorney. Motion seconded by Councilman Crane. Unanimously carried.
- (c) The Council was advised that the Town of Goodyear will participate in applying for Criminal Justice Planning Funds to rehabilitate the Avondale City Jail. The City Manager has asked the League of Arizona Cities and Towns for application forms.
- (d) The Council was advised that a request by Mr. James D. Finley for a use permit at 705 E Western Avenue for electronics assembly was denied. The City Attorney informed the Mayor and Council that in accordance with the Zoning Ordinance a variance should have been requested rather than a use permit. Therefore, Mr. Finley could re-apply under a variance request.

New Business:

- (a) The canvass of votes cast in the General Election held on Tuesday, December 14, 1971, was held at this meeting. The returns were reviewed by the Council and are as follows:

New Business Cont'd

City Attorney Barnes discussed with the Mayor and Council the provisions of Article 15, Section 16-1001, Automatic recount; requirements, Arizona Revised Statutes. City Attorney Barnes pointed out that this section did not refer to City Elections but that it would be a Council decision if this section should apply for automatic recount pertaining to the General Election. Councilman Crane moved that Article 15, Section 16-1001 be applied to the General Election held on December 14, 1971 and that the City Attorney prepare the necessary documents to be forwarded to the Maricopa County Superior Court ordering a recount at the expense of the City of Avondale. Motion seconded by Councilman Summers. Roll call vote follows:

Abstained: Watson, Sernas and Lorenz

Nayes: None

- (b) The Council was advised that Mr. Harold Sprague had resigned from the Avondale Planning Commission as he had moved from the City. Mayor Allen moved that the appointment of a replacement be tabled until the next regular meeting. Motion seconded by Councilwoman Lorenz. Unanimously carried.
- (c) Mr. Charles P. Lorenz has petitioned for the annexation of a piece of his property into the City Limits. Said petition was presented to the Avondale Planning Commission for review and recommended that said annexation be approved and that said property be zoned R-5. Vice-Mayor Campbell moved that upon submission by Mr. Lorenz to the City Attorney a complete legal description of the property that an Ordinance be prepared for presentation to the Council. Motion seconded by Councilman Summers. Unanimously carried. Councilwoman Lorenz abstained.
- (d) A mutual assistance and aid agreement between the Maricopa County Board of Supervisors and the cities and towns of the Westside was presented to the Council and City Attorney. Councilman Summers moved that the City of Avondale enter into a mutual assistance and aid agreement with the Maricopa County Board of Supervisors. Motion seconded by Councilman Sernas. Unanimously carried.

New Business Cont'd

- (e) The City Manager respectfully requested authorization to redeem three Certificates of Deposit that mature on December 21, 1971 and re-invest said funds. Certificates maturing are as follows:

Councilman Crane moved that the City Manager be authorized to redeem the above certificates and re-invest said funds. Motion seconded by Councilwoman Lorenz. Unanimously carried.

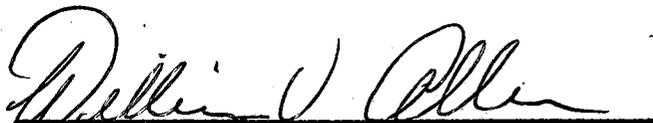

Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Council of the City of Avondale, Arizona, held at 7:30 P.M., January 3, 1972, in the Council Chambers of the Avondale City Hall

Minutes of the Previous Meeting:

Minutes of the regular meeting of December 20, 1971, were included as part of the Agenda for Council's review. Since there were no corrections or additions to the minutes, Mayor Allen moved, seconded by Councilwoman Lorenz, that the minutes be approved as reviewed by the Council. Carried Unanimously.

Reports:

- (a) The City Manager gave an oral report on the Maricopa County City Manager's seminar held on December 29th.
- (b) Included with the Agenda was a copy of questions and answers on Phase II prepared by the International City Management Association.
- (c) Included with the Agenda was a copy of the Management Police Directive For Loss Prevention Program for Council's information. Councilwoman Lorenz noted that hospitalization or visits to a physician regarding work incurred injuries will be made with supervisory authorization only. In her opinion this should be changed as in some instances supervisory personnel would not be available in emergency cases and the individual should be treated with the least possible delay. Mr. Gomez, Safety Director said that he would bring this to the attention of the Safety Committee at their next scheduled meeting.

Demand Claims:

The City Manager respectfully requested that an additional demand claim number 12020, payable to Sandra Anthony for services at the City Court in the amount of \$57.60, be included. Councilman Watson moved that the demand claims including the additional claim submitted for payment be approved. Motion seconded by Councilman Crane. Unanimously carried.

Unfinished Business:

(a) Final discussion on an agreement to lease a computer from Automated Business Systems was held at this meeting. Mayor Allen moved that if the changes recommended by City Attorney Barnes were acceptable by Automated Business Systems that the City enter into the agreement to lease the computer. Motion seconded by Councilman Sernas. Unanimously carried.

(b) City Attorney Barnes stated that from the Canvass of Votes held on December 20, 1971, that Councilman A. B. Sernas with 249 votes and Councilwoman Dessie M. Lorenz with 201 votes could be declared elected. Mayor Allen moved that on the basis of the canvass of votes that Councilman A. B. Sernas be declared elected for a four year term to the Council of the City of Avondale. Motion seconded by Vice-Mayor Campbell. Roll call vote follows: Ayes: Watson, Campbell, Lorenz and Mayor Allen. Nays: None

Mayor Allen moved that on the basis of the canvass of votes that Councilwoman Dessie M. Lorenz be declared elected for a four year term to the Council of the City of Avondale. Motion seconded by Councilman Crane. Roll call vote follows: Ayes: Watson, Campbell, Sernas, Crane and Mayor Allen. Nays: None

Oath of Office was administered to Mayor Allen, Councilwoman Lorenz and Councilman Sernas, by the City Clerk.

City Attorney Barnes read a Resolution declaring results of canvass of General Election held on December 14, 1971; authorizing certification to Superior Court of facts requiring a recount as to one Councilman Office and declaring an emergency. This Resolution was discussed by the Mayor and Council and the City Attorney with Mr. Frank Vizzerra. Mayor Allen moved that this Resolution be tabled until Mr. Vizzerra could check further into the laws governing the automatic recount. Motion seconded by Councilman Sernas. Unanimously carried. Councilman Watson abstained.

Unfinished Business (Cont'd)

- (c) The Council was advised that Mr. Robert Norton of Johannessen and Girand had not completed the final proposal for the drainage system in Goodyear Meadows Subdivision. The proposal should be received before the next regular scheduled meeting.
- (d) The Council was advised that the annexation map for the annexation of the Lorenz property on Harrison Street is being prepared by professional engineers and as soon as it was available an Ordinance would be prepared by the City Attorney and presented to the Council.

New Business:

- (a) Included with the Agenda was a letter from Mr. Alan M. Borup requesting help in conducting a transportation survey in the City of Avondale. After discussion by the Mayor and Council, Councilwoman Lorenz moved that this item be tabled until further study and information be obtained regarding the study. Motion seconded by Vice-Mayor Campbell. Unanimously carried.
- (b) The City Manager respectfully requested authorization to attend the Annual Arizona City Managers conference in Tucson on January 13 and 14. A copy of the Agenda for said conference was included with the Agenda. Vice-Mayor Campbell moved that the City Manager be authorized to attend the Annual Arizona City Managers Conference. Motion seconded by Councilman Crane. Unanimously carried.
- (c) Mr. James R. Bacon, Representative of the Public Employees Union discussed union representation of City Employees with the Mayor, Council and City Attorney. Mayor Allen informed Mr. Bacon that the Council would take Union recommendations under advisement.

Extra:

The City Manager read a letter from Mr. Hollar, Maricopa County Housing Authority, requesting a no fee building permits regarding the construction of the low cost housing project in Avondale. Mayor Allen moved that a letter be forwarded authorizing a no fee building permit to Maricopa County Housing Authority. Motion seconded by Vice-Mayor Campbell. Unanimously carried.

Extra (Cont'd)

The City Manager discussed with the Mayor and Council and City Attorney the difficulties encountered in assisting Police Departments in neighboring Cities and Towns. Mayor Allen moved that the Police Department be directed not to render aid to other Cities and Towns until a written mutual aid agreement be executed between other Cities and Towns. Motion seconded by Councilman Crane. Unanimously carried.

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RESOLUTION NO. 183

RESOLUTION DECLARING RESULTS OF CANVASS OF GENERAL ELECTION HELD ON DECEMBER 14, 1971; AUTHORIZING CERTIFICATION TO SUPERIOR COURT OF FACTS REQUIRING A RECOUNT AS TO ONE COUNCILMAN OFFICE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF AVONDALE, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. That the City Council has canvassed as required by law the votes cast at the City of Avondale General Election held on December 14, 1971, for the purpose of electing at large three city councilmen, each to serve for a term of four years; that said canvass of the vote results as certified by the election board established that a total of 408 ballots were cast at said election, of which total 8 ballots were rejected by the election board; and that the number of votes received by candidates were as follows:

A.B. Sernas	249 votes
Dessie M. Lorenz	201 votes
Frank M. Vizzerra	179 votes
John M. Watson	177 votes
Esiquiel D. (Zeke) Ramos	159 votes
Jerry Stewart	131 votes
Virginia Pausig (Write In)	1 vote
Chuck Manning (Write In)	1 vote

SECTION TWO. That said canvass of the votes showed that two candidates were elected as city councilmen, namely, A.B. Sernas and Dessie M. Lorenz, and said two candidates are hereby declared to be elected to serve four year terms as city councilmen; that said canvass of the votes further established that with respect to the third city councilman office, the two candidates receiving the highest numbers of votes therefor, Frank M. Vizzerra and John M. Watson, were separated in vote totals by but two votes, and thus were within a margin of ten votes of each other, and therefore by the provisions of Section 16-1001,

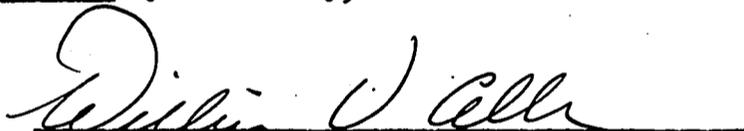
Arizona Revised Statutes, a recount of the vote upon the candidacies of Frank M. Vizzerra and John M Watson.is required.

SECTION THREE. That the City Council does hereby authorize William G. Barnes, City Attorney, to take appropriate steps in accordance with Arizona law to cause said recount of votes for said office to be authorized and held; that the City Council does hereby authorize Mayor William V. Allen and City Clerk Ernest W. Kleinschmidt to act for, on behalf of, and in the name of the City Council and the City of Avondale in providing and executing all certifications, pleadings, exhibits, documents, materials, information and other matters of any nature or type that may be appropriate for or required for the City Council or the City of Avondale to provide, supply or execute in connection with actions, activities or procedures leading to or constituting a requisite for such recount of votes; that the City Council does further declare that in accordance with Section 16-1005, Arizona Revised Statutes, the expenses of said recount of votes shall be a city charge.

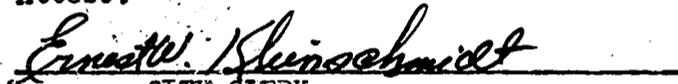

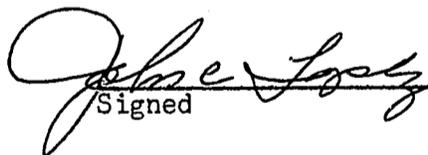
