

Minutes of the emergency special meeting of December 19, 1983 held at 9:06 p.m.

Mayor Lorenz explained to the Council and the audience that the purpose of this emergency meeting is to canvass the votes of the general election which was held on December 13, 1983. She stated that the emergency is created by the following factors:

- 1) Arizona law requires that votes be canvassed on the Monday following the election.
- 2) Through inadvertence, this item was not added to the agenda for the regular meeting of December 19, 1983.
- 3) The state open meeting law prohibits the addition of items to the agenda within 24 hours of a meeting.
- 4) The state open meeting law does permit the calling of a public meeting with less than 24 hours notice in the case of an actual emergency.

Councilman Lundmark made a motion that this is an actual emergency. Councilman Crane seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

The City Clerk Linda Tyler read for the Council the results of the election. They are as follows:
