Mrs. Tyler reported to the Council that there were 28 question ballots and 24 of these were verified, four were rejected because the electors were not registered. Mrs. Tyler stated that two council seats were filled by Joe Guzman and Lon Montgomery. Those qualifying for the General Election on December 13, 1983 are Dessie Lorenz and Bob Wolfe for Mayor and A. B. Sernas and Bruce Lundmark for Council.

Mr. Palma brought to the Council's attention a letter the City Clerk had received from Maricopa County Elections Department apologizing for shortcomings that were noted during this primary election. Mayor Lorenz asked that this letter be submitted to the Westsider to inform the citizens that the problems experienced during the election were not on the part of the City.
