

The regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of Avondale was held May 4, 1959, in the City Hall in Avondale.

Opening of Meeting:

Mayor Brinker called the meeting to order promptly at 7:30 P. M.

Reading of the Minutes:

The minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Common Council held April 20, 1959, were read by the City Clerk and upon motion of Mr. Campbell, second by Mr. Howe, were passed and approved as read by unanimous vote.

Del Monte Paving:

It was reported that paving in the Del Monte district has been started.

Improvement District:

Johannessen and Girard, Engineers, will report May 18, 1959.

Primary Election of April 21, 1959:

The locked election box holding the records of the Primary Election held April 21, 1959, was unlocked and contents noted.

After inspection of the Tally and other records, a motion was made that the Tally as submitted by the Election Board, is a true and correct tally, motion being made by Mr. Howe, seconded by Mr. Kingsbury and carried by a unanimous vote.

Mr. Flynn of Shumway Construction:

City Clerk explained that Mr. Flynn was asked to appear at the meeting so that a settlement could be reached upon the amount of the invoice due from Shumway Construction Company to the City of Avondale for broken water lines and other damages caused by the Construction of the sewer. The invoice originally submitted for payment, was considered by Shumway Construction Company to be in excess of the damage done by them, therefore, a new invoice was given to them listing not only the cost of materials shown in invoice first submitted, but the labor ~~on~~ necessary to repair the breaks in the water lines, and rental of equipment loaned to Shumway by the City, of which no mention had been made up to the time of rejection of the original invoice. Mr. Flynn stated that their frontoffice did not know of the equipment loaned to them, and that their Company had done favors for the City of Avondale also. This was agreed to by the Council. After further discussion, a motion was made by Mr. Campbell, seconded

Transportation to Convention:

It was suggested that all those attending the Convention at Williams contact each other and arrange transportation so that as few cars be taken as necessary, and the time for arrival be arranged.

Young Condemnation of Property:

Mr. Parsons reported that a new figure had been submitted to him in the Young condemnation case, containing legal fees. Mr. Parsons was advised that proposed amounts would not be considered, that if settlement could not be reached on the amounts as originally shown, other steps would have to be taken at the proper time.

Publication of the Charter:

Mr. Parsons stated that the publication of the charged according to law, was for three weekly publications where the paper was a weekly rather than daily, and from the last publication the election had to be held within ~~thirty~~ thirty days but not less than twenty days.

It was announced that the election upon the acceptance of the charter as a city charger would be held June 8, 1959.

EXECUTIVE SESSION:

The Mayor declared the meeting now to be in executive session only, the Hall was cleared.

Mr. Coleman stated that Mr. Curtis J. Stewart had resigned from the Police Department effective as of May 1, 1959.

Applications for patrolmen were inspected and discussed and the posting of notice of applications now being received for this position ordered.

Open Meeting:

The doors were opened to continue the Council Meeting for discussion as to the need of a magistrate being on call ^{at all} office hours. It was stated that the present magistrate when needed might be several places and could not be easily located, and that one from the office would be more practical.

Motion was made that Mr. ^{Jensen} ~~Jones~~, present magistrate be replaced May 15, 1959, by Agnes Rymer, but that his salary be paid for the full month of May. Mr. Campbell made the motion, Mr. Kingsbury seconded it, and it carried unanimously.

Demand Claims:

Mr. Campbell made the motion, Mr. Howe seconded it, and it was passed that the Demand Claims be approved for payment

Meeting Adjourned:

As there was no further business to come before the Council, Mr. Howe made the motion, seconded by Mr. Kingsbury and passed that the meeting be adjourned.
