Can I Request to Speak? The Avondale City Council provides members of the public with an opportunity to speak at every Regular City Council Meeting. Anyone wishing to address the Council, should fill out a Request to Speak card and submit it to the City Clerk prior to the start of the meeting. Speakers will be acknowledged by the Mayor and will be given three minutes to make comments. If more than five requests to speak are received, comments will be limited to one minute.

2. PRESENTATION ITEMS

Purpose: Presentation items are for the purpose of presenting staff announcements to City Council. No formal action may be taken during this time.

- Presentations and/or discussions **will** occur on Presentation items.
- Request to Speak cards **are** accepted on Presentation items.

3. UNSCHEDULED PUBLIC APPEARANCES

4. CONSENT AGENDA ITEMS

Purpose: Consent Agenda items are for the purpose of taking formal action on items that are routine in nature. There will be no discussion on items within this category and they will be approved quickly through one motion. An item may be pulled off the Consent Agenda for further discussion at the request of Council.

- Presentations and/or discussions will **not** occur on Consent Agenda items.
- Request to Speak cards **are** accepted on Consent Agenda items.

5. REGULAR AGENDA ITEMS

Purpose: Regular Agenda items are for the purpose of taking formal action on items that require more in-depth consideration. There will be a staff presentation followed by an in-depth discussion among the Council. All items on the Regular Agenda are discussed and approved separately.

- Presentations and/or discussions **will** occur on Regular Agenda items.
- Request to Speak cards **are** accepted on Regular Agenda items.

What is a Public Hearing? Public Hearing items are occasionally placed as a Regular Agenda item for the purpose of providing the public with a formal opportunity to speak on a related agenda item. Some examples of items that require a formal Public Hearing include annexations, budget adoptions, and land zoning changes.

6. SUMMARY OF CURRENT EVENTS FROM MAYOR, VICE MAYOR, AND COUNCIL MEMBERS

Purpose: Summary of Current Events is for the purpose of providing Mayor, Vice Mayor, and Council Members with an opportunity to speak on current events. City Council will receive a total of 5 minutes to speak in this category.

- Presentations and/or discussions will **not** occur on the Summary of Current Event item.
- Request to Speak cards are **not** accepted on the Summary of Current Event item.

7. EXECUTIVE SESSION ITEMS (added as needed)

Purpose: Executive Sessions items are discussed under limited circumstances (pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03). The public is not allowed to attend Executive Session meetings and no formal action of the City Council may be taken.

- Presentations and/or discussions will occur **privately** on Executive Sessions items.
- Request to Speak cards are **not** accepted on Executive Sessions items.
